NARCAN (Naxolone HCI)




A Nasal Spray is used for known or suspected opioid overdose in adults and children.



Naloxone is an opioid antagonist, it binds to the same receptors as the opioids and temporarily blocks their effects.





In 2021, more than 100,000 people died.

The rate of <u>synthetic opioid</u> <u>overdose deaths</u> rose 22%
